If an emergency does arise, you get a taxi safely home and RideOn gets the bill.

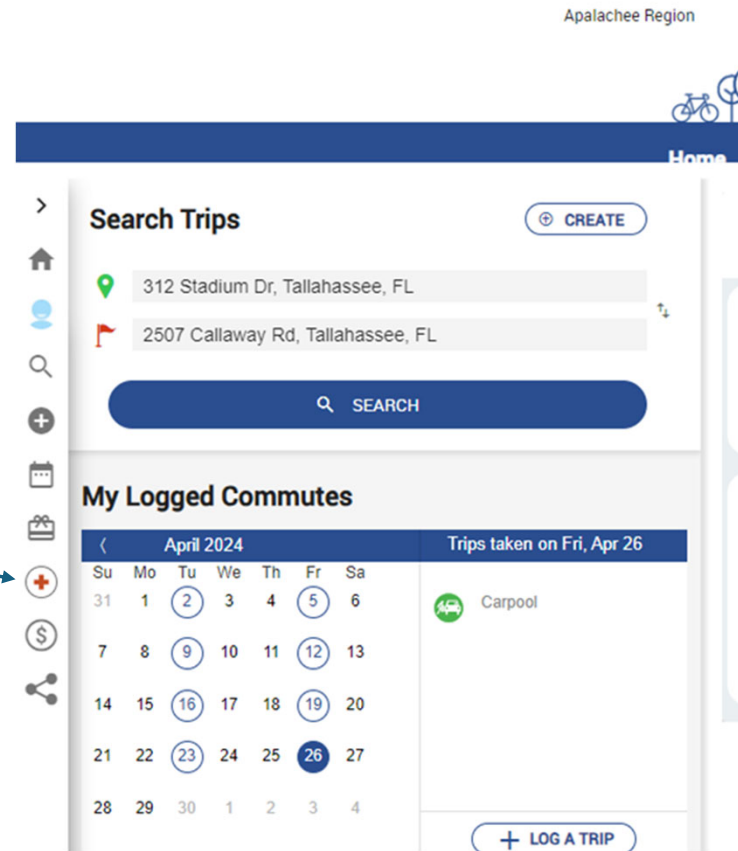

Emergency Ride Home Policy Agreement

To be eligible, Commuters must:

1. Be 18 years or older
2. Live OR work OR attend post-secondary school within the CAP region
3. Keep a trip log to verify use of a sustainable mode (carpool, vanpool, bus, bike or walk) to travel to and from work or school at least 3 days per week

Authorization will be given when:

1. The commuter is eligible under the program criteria AND
2. Only for permitted trips
3. From work to home (or P&R lot); a stop directly related to the emergency (such as picking up a sick child) is permitted
4. Disruption was unforeseen (such as illness or unexpected overtime). If your driver will be on vacation or bus service is on weekends/ holiday schedule, you need to make other arrangements.
5. No excessive use (after 3 uses per calendar year, you must contact the ERH program administrator for authorization on a case by case basis)

By submitting this record, I confirm that I qualify under the stated eligibility requirements and understand that abuse or improper use of the program will result in disqualification.
