Official Contest Rules and Regulations

Smart Commute in Durham Region “Bike Month” Campaign (the “Contest”)

Please read these official Rules and Regulations and the Notice of Collection in their entirety before entering the Contest. You are not eligible to enter the Contest unless you agree to these official Rules and Regulations. Participation in the Contest constitutes full and unconditional agreement and acceptance of these official Rules and Regulations, which are final on all matters relating to the Contest.

The Regional Municipality of Durham (“Durham Region”) and Smart Commute Transportation Management Associations (“Smart Commute”) are administrators of the Contest.

Durham Region, Smart Commute and their respective employees, elected and non-elected officials, agents, successors, volunteers, students and assigns shall not be held responsible for any costs, losses, damages or expenses arising by reason of accident, negligence, printing, administrative or other errors that may arise or occur in connection with the Contest. Durham Region and Smart Commute reserve the right to modify, amend, suspend, or terminate this Contest and these Contest Rules and Regulations, without prior notice, with no obligation or liability to any person entering the Contest.

Contest Duration

The Contest starts on June 1, 2026, at 12:01 a.m. ET and ends on June 30, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. ET (the “Contest Period”).

Eligibility

No purchase is necessary to enter.

The Contest is open to all residents of Ontario who are eighteen (18) years old or older at the time of entry.

To be eligible to participate in this Contest, everyone entering the Contest (“Contestant”) must:

- Log a trip on smartcommute.ca or respective app during the Contest Period.



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Contestants must provide the following details with their submission:

- First and last name
- Email address

Incomplete entries will be voided.

How to Enter

During the Contest Period, a Contestant entering the Contest must complete the Bike Month entries (“Entry” or “Entries”) by logging a bike trip on the Smart Commute Tool (www.smartcommute.ca). New users will need to register an account to log a bike trip.

One (1) logged bike trip will be entered as one entry ballot per user, contestants are limited up to a maximum of two (2) entries per day. New users who create their account during the Contest Period and log more than two (2) bike trips gain one (1) entry to the Contest.

Trips made during the Contest Period must be logged by July 7, 11:59 p.m. ET to qualify for the prize draw.

Entries generated by script, macro or other automated means, and Entries by any means which subvert these Official Contest Rules and Regulations are null and void.

All Entries become the sole property of Durham Region and Smart Commute and will not be returned to Contestants. Contestants grant non-exclusive intellectual property rights to Durham Region and Smart Commute to use and reproduce the Entries, including but not limited to any submitted information that are part of the Entries, as Durham Region and Smart Commute in their sole and absolute discretion consider appropriate in accordance with these Official Contest Rules and Regulations. By submitting an Entry, Contestants irrevocably and unconditionally waive, in favour of Durham Region and Smart Commute, all moral rights the Contestant has or may have in the Entry.

Entries will be screened for appropriateness. Entries that are inappropriate in nature or do not relate to the Contest will be null and void. Appropriateness of the Entries is determined at the sole and exclusive discretion of Durham Region and Smart Commute.



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Durham Region and Smart Commute are not responsible for technical problems with submitting Entries. If Entries submitted cannot be viewed or any submitted Entries do not satisfy the Contest requirements, such Entries will be voided.

Entries

All entries become the property of Durham Region and Smart Commute, and none shall be returned. The Entry submitted must not infringe on copyright or other intellectual property rights.

There are five (5) prizes to be won.

Prize Winner Selections and Notification

At the end of the Contest Period, representatives of Smart Commute will randomly select five (5) winners from the valid Entries made during the Contest Period.

The odds of winning depend on the number of valid Entries received.

The winner will be announced no later than July 31, 2026. Each Contest winner must reply within ten (10) business days.

All prize winners must meet the eligibility rules in order to claim the prize. Smart Commute will notify each selected winner by email.

If a Contest winner does not respond to Smart Commute within ten (10) business days of being notified that their entry was selected the Contest winner will be disqualified and their entitlement to receive the prize will be declared null and void. Smart Commute reserves



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the right, in its sole discretion, to select another eligible Entry as the Contest winner, in which event these provisions shall apply to such other eligible Entry.

In the event that Durham Region and/or Smart Commute incorrectly announces a Contestant as a winner, then Durham Region and/or Smart Commute may rescind the announcement and declare the intended winner, or no winner at all, without any liability to the Contestant who was incorrectly declared as a winner.

Claiming Any Prize

Within ten (10) business days of being confirmed a qualified prize winner, that person will be responsible for responding to Durham Region and/or Smart Commute in order to receive their prize. Failure to respond within the ten (10) daytime period will render that person's prize void.
