

# Menu of Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Services for Sea-Tac Airport Employers

We can help your company provide alternative commute benefits to your employees!

The South King County Transportation Options (SKCTO) team will provide free TDM consultation and assistance to employers located at the Sea-Tac Airport to encourage employees to try an alternative commute (e.g. carpool, vanpool, bus, train, bike, walk) as part of a grant that will run until mid-2019.

## **Employer Transportation Subsidy Programs**

- **ORCA Business Passport**: A comprehensive annual transportation pass for all employees
- **ORCA Business Choice**: Load a monthly dollar amount or a variety of passes onto employee ORCA cards at retail pricing
- **Grant-funded ORCA cards**: SKCTO is offering airport employees reloadable ORCA cards with an initial balance of \$20 to encourage them to try commuting by transit and ongoing opportunities to reload their card and earn other rewards by logging their non-drive-alone trips on <u>SKCtrips.com</u>
- Vanpool/Vanshare: A Vanpool consists of five or more members who share a similar commute. Vans, insurance, and gas are provided. Fares are based on mileage, number of riders, and size of van. If your company enrolls in ORCA Passport, Vanpools are likely covered by Passport. A Vanshare can bridge the last mile from a train station or Park & Ride.

- Employer-based transportation options training for employees

- Worksite Transportation Assessment: Site visit to assess opportunities to improve amenities and incentives for non-drive-alone commuters
- **Transportation Management Plan (TMP) Assistance**: Co-develop or update a plan to improve alternative commuter amenities at your worksite
- Assistance exploring innovative mobility options, such as shared employer shuttles

# Capital Infrastructure/Amenities

- Planning and design assistance for transportation-related amenities with potential to partially or fully fund project:
  - Bicycle facilities (racks, lockers, repair stations)
  - Carpool/VanPool stall signage
  - Wayfinding signage
  - TransitScreen real-time transit information
  - Wall-mounted displays for transportation information
